Request a Waterfront Exemption Certificate (WFEC) from the current owner (signed and endorsed by a Sylvania Waterways Ltd Director).



WFEC provided, read and understand requirements to obtain license

The WFEC will identify any waterfront non compliance issues and items that are the responsibility of the new owner.

Submit application for membership Form 1014 with membership application fee \$5000 & Waterfront License Fee \$4000 to Sylvania Waterways Ltd (SWL)



Sylvania Waterways managing agent to issue payment receipt, welcome letter and invitation to attend one hour new member introduction meeting. Meetings held first Wednesday of every month commencing at 6pm. Pre-booking essential.



At introduction meeting new member collects Share Certificate, meets company Directors and is provided with information in relation to the maintenance of their sea wall.



New Member attends to any outstanding items on WFEC e.g. orders Engineers Sea Wall Inspection Report, installs life buoy, attends to outstanding non compliance, completes required sea wall maintenance etc. New Member confirms actions completed.



SWL issue new Waterfront License.
